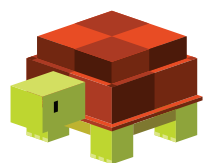

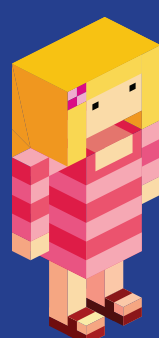
## TEEN SCENE

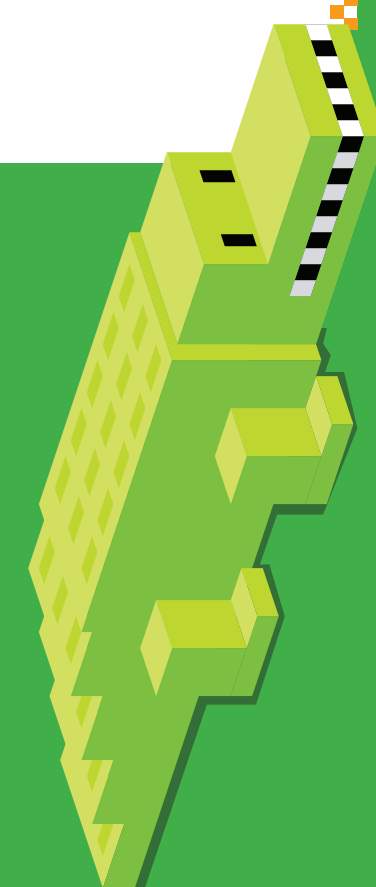
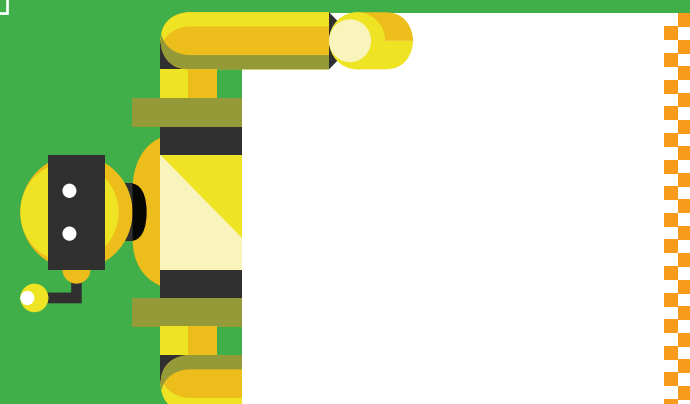
